2. Conceive and execute thematic occasion floral designs.
3. Create floral decorations for a variety of special events.

### **Assignment:**

1. Create floral designs for special events on campus.
2. Final project: Assemble portfolio including photos of decorated special events with journal entries describing type of event, theme, and decorations used.
3. Repeating students are expected to create advanced designs, use seasonal materials, and produce projects with increased speed.
