  - b. Green hits in regulation from fairway
  - c. Total putts on putting green
2. Measure all scores with differential scoring of:
  - a. 9-hole play
  - b. 18 hole play
3. Formulate goal cards for consistent evaluation and innovation.
  - a. Practice and match

### **Topics and Scope:**

#### **A. OUTLINE OF SKILLS TO BE COVERED IN THE COURSE**

1. Full pitch and wedge shots from:
  - a. 40-60-80 yds
  - b. 50-70-90 yds
  - c. 60-80-110 yds
2. Driving Range work (all clubs)
  - a. Irons (T-shots and fairway)
  - b. Woods (T-shots and fairway)
3. Concentrated drills with scoring clubs around green
  - a. Up and down: chip and pitch shots
  - b. Short-medium-long: Putting
  - c. Trouble shots: sand, side, up, downhill lies
4. Mental aspects of course management
  - a- goal cards (practice and match)
  - b. Differential scoring

## Assignment:

Each golfer will maintain a "how to chart and record" stat sheets which will indentify their progress toward the goals and objectives of the class.
