- 2. Use correct techniques and postures while learning the 10-key pad.



Students who fail to log on and initiate participation by 11:59 of the first day of class may be dropped by the instructor.

DROPPING THE CLASS

If you decide to discontinue this course, it is your responsibility to officially drop it. A student may be dropped from any class when that student's absences exceed ten percent of the total hours of class time. It is strongly advised that if you need to miss more than one class/homework deadline in a row, that you contact the instructor to avoid being dropped from the class.

LATE POLICY

Although we are working at our own pace, you must finish the lessons as assigned. If you are missing two deadlines in a row, you may be dropped from the class. If your work is more than one week late, it will not be accepted.

EVALUATION

Lessons - 40%

Completion of 24 lessons of 1-minute timed writings with a minimum job entry speed of 11,000 keystrokes per hour (B grade) and an accuracy rate of 98% or higher.

Skill Performance Tests 40%

Completion of 8 timing tests of various lengths including 2 minutes, 3 minutes, 4 minutes, and 5 minutes (as indicated on each lesson) with a minimum job entry speed of 11000 keystrokes per hour) and an accuracy rate of 98% or higher.

Quizzes - 10 %

Completion of quizzes detailing specific information from text relating to vocabulary and the ergonomic work environment.

Other Assignments - 10%

Performance and tracking of breaks/ exercises/ stretches demonstrating good ergonomic techniques while keying 40 points. These will include readings and discussion posts.
