**Course Description:** Flors 105 Flowers to Wear and Carry 1 unit; P/NP option; Prerequisite: Completion of Flors 83A

The primary purpose of this class is for the student to become more proficient in the proper construction of corsages, wristlets, boutonnieres, wearable flowers and hand held designs. We will discuss and practice the use of different types of mechanics including gluing, wiring and taping. Other topics will be scale, balance and proportion. We will use a variety of fresh and permanent materials. We will learn specific care and handling of these materials.
