Course Description:

This course is a continuation and expansion of Elementary French 1 designed **for students who have taken French 1 or who have had two years of school French**

Prerequisites

FREN 1 or two years of high school French

Required texts:

Atelier (1st edition) and the accompanying **access to Mindtap** are available for purchase in the SRJC Bookstore. We will cover Chapters 7 to 12 in this course.

You can also buy the eBook and Platform through the Cengage website.

Learning goals:

During the semester, you will develop literacy skills in French by reading, writing, listening, and talking about various topics. I expect you to spend about 2 to 4 hours per week preparing for class sessions to achieve these goals. Because we know that input and interaction in French are essential to developing proficiency, the class will be conducted almost entirely in French.

At the end of the semester, you will be able

- ☐ To communicate in spontaneous spoken and written conversations about everyday topics.

- ☐ To identify general topics and basic information about everyday life in spoken, written, or visual texts.
- ☐ To present general topics and basic information in spoken, written, or visual productions.
- ☐ To identify products and practices from your own and other cultures and understand perspectives.

In-class/Zoom participation & Attendance:

Language acquisition requires steady, constant, daily exposure to meaningful messages in the language you are studying. Success in this class is based on your engagement with texts and activities. You are expected to prepare yourself in advance for each day's learning activities and approach each class period and each learning activity with knowledge of new vocabulary and grammar rules. You are responsible for constantly reviewing all the material covered during homework and classwork. If you cannot attend class, please let your instructors know.

Attendance is mandatory in this course; your instructor will evaluate your attendance and in-class participation every week. You will receive 8 points/week in total: 2 points/day for attendance and 2 points/day for participation. Being absent from the course will impact the participation evaluation. Your participation grade will be reflected through your engagement in class discussion, group work, and positive attitude towards your peers and instructor. It is your responsibility to come to class prepared and on time.

Class Preparation & Homework:

Class preparation and homework are essential to succeed in this course. Every week a "Feuille de Route" (Roadmap) will be posted on the online course management CANVAS. The weekly roadmap will give you detailed instructions on the assignments you have to do and where and when to submit these assignments.

Additionally, it will show material that must be prepared and brought to class.

Most of the homework exercises are online in **MindTap**. You are required to complete all exercises assigned in **MindTap**. You may redo the exercises as often as you want (up to ten attempts) until you have 100% correct. Your instructor will check to see if you complete the work on time.

Quizzes

You will regularly take short quizzes online to evaluate your learning and understanding of grammar and vocabulary. Being prepared and learning materials are central to this course.

Module Exams:

The three-module exams are designed to assess your understanding of the topics and readings and your use of vocabulary and structures. Each exam is divided into 4 sections: writing, reading, speaking, and listening. These exams will be taken online via Canvas.

Final Project: The final project will replace the traditional final exam and will be completed in the last week of class. Your presence is crucial to succeeding in this final project. Because the final project will be presented on the last day of class, there will be NO makeup.
